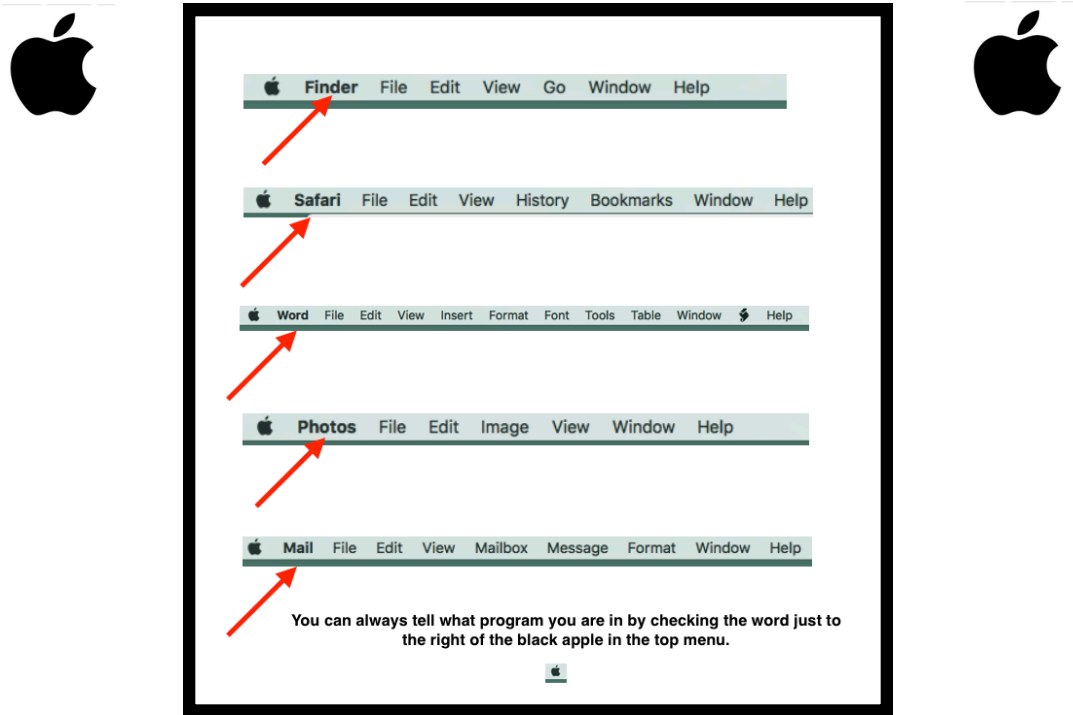


## Check Which Program is Active on Your Mac

### How do I know which program is active on my screen?

1. Look at your top menu. Find the **Black Apple**. Look to the right. The program that is active on your screen shows up in **bold** print.

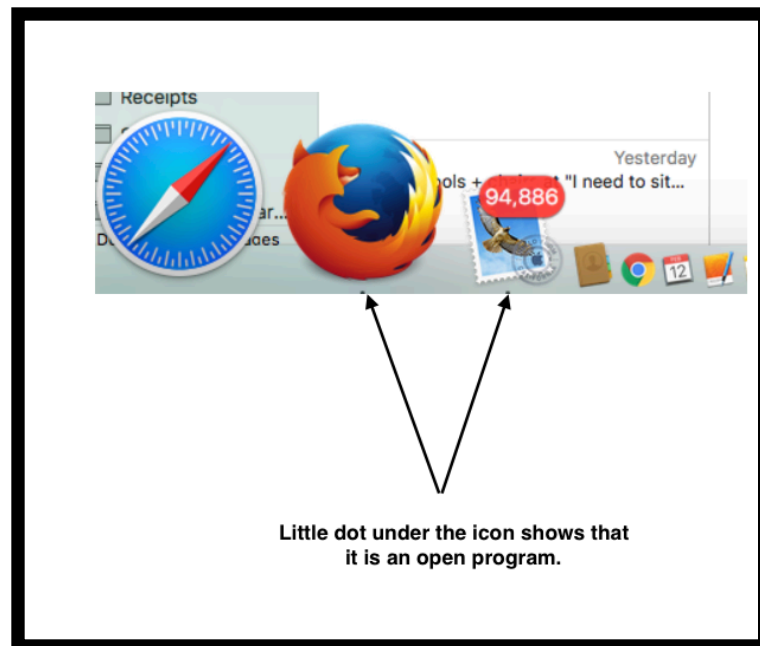


Your **top menu** will always start (left to right) Black Apple, name of the program that is active, File, and then Edit. After Edit the menu changes depending on what program is open.

2. Check you **dock (the row of icons at the bottom of your screen or on the left or right side)**.



When a program is open, you can see a tiny black dot under its icon in the dock.



3. By the way, you have control over where your dock is and how big the icons are in **System Preferences** which you can find under the Black Apple. **Dock** is in the top line once System Preferences opens.
